One or more members of the Board may participate in the meeting by telephonic communications.

The meeting is open to the public. However, during the course of the meeting, the Board, upon a majority vote of a quorum of the members, may, when necessary, hold an executive session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(2) and/or (3) as indicated on the Board's Agenda. The executive session is not open to the public.

The Board reserves the right to change the order of the agenda items, except for matters set for a specific time.

These recommendations do not become final until adopted by the Board. The Board has the authority to accept, reject or modify any recommendation listed in the agenda.

The Board, however, may ask staff to review a matter or may ask that a matter be put on a future agenda.
