CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order at 2:32 p.m. by Dr. Herro. Roll call of the committee members was taken and a quorum was established.

II. REVIEW, DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

A. Discussion and approval of the Open Session Minutes from the December 13, 2022 committee meeting.

Motion: Dr. Herro moved to approve the Open Session Minutes from the December

13, 2022 committee meeting.

Second: Dr. Lout

Vote: 8-aye, 0-nay, 0-abstain, 0-recuse, 2-absent. Motion passed.

III. NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING ("NPR")

The Committee reviewed A.A.C. R4-11-1304 related to a permit holder's ability to employ or work with an anesthesia or sedation provider. During discussion, Dr. Caputo provided the Committee a historical overview of dental permits. The Committee proceeded to discuss the regulatory oversight of non-dental anesthesia providers and considered that eliminating the 1304 Permit would cause an access to care issue. Dr. Arnall addressed the Committee and commented that the general dentist may not know the reporting requirements and stated that CRNA's are not required to report adverse occurrences to the Dental Board. Dr. Arnall further stated that the Dental Board should have regulatory oversight for what happens at a dental office. In addition, Mr. Rodriguez informed the committee that other states have inter-committees. The Committee took guest's suggestions into consideration and further discussed the matter. The consensus of the Committee was to not restrict the ability of a CRNA or non-dental provider to provide care at a dental office. Dr. Caputo suggested that the Committee draft a list of requirements that would create a safe practice in order for a dentist to work with a non-dental provider. In addition, to ensure that dentists know what level of responsibility they are accountable for. After consideration, the Committee concurred to continue the review of R4-11-1304 at the next meeting.

IV. AGENCY SUBSTANTIVE POLICY STATEMENT

The Committee reviewed substantive policy statement no. 28 related to competency case requirements for renewal of sedation permits and concurred to recommend that the Board consider repealing it at its next board meeting.
