B. Investigative Interview(s)

2. 202200175

Dr. Mansoor was available during the Committee's consideration of the matter. Attorney Patrick White was also available. Ms. Romero provided the Committee an overview of the case pertaining to alleged improper dental treatment for crowns and failure to provide appropriate refund for incomplete treatment. The investigator did not find deviations from the standard of care for the work performed; however, did find that a refund was not provided. Dr. Mansoor proceeded to answer questions pertaining to the refund. The patient requested a twenty-four thousand dollar refund and rejected the partial refund that was offered. Dr. Mansoor explained that the patient alleged having an infection; however, refused to allow her to review the treatment and requested a refund and indicated that treatment was completed in Texas. Dr. Mansoor further explained the technicalities of the procedure and breakdown of charges. The Committee proceeded to discuss whether the offered restitution amount was appropriate considering the final restorations were not fabricated by the lab. However, the Committee concurred with the consultant's report that there was no violation of the standard of care.

Motion: Ms. Kappes moved to recommend dismissal of the case. Second: Dr. Berrigan Vote: 8-aye, 0-nay, 0-abstain, 0-recuse, 1-absent, 2-vacancies. Motion passed.

1. 202200090-MP

Dr. Spillers was available during the Committee's consideration of the matter. Attorney Michelle Thompson was also available and made a statement regarding the drug prescribed prior to the procedure and clarified that it was 0.25 milligrams. In addition, Ms. Thompson indicated that the patient was referred to a neurologist after the first time the patient indicated having symptoms of a nerve injury. Ms. Romero proceeded to provide the Committee an overview of the case. Dr. Spillers subsequently provided clarification with regard to the prescribed dosage and indicated his documentation is significantly better than five years ago. The Committee proceeded to discuss whether there was a violation of inadequate record-keeping and failure to refer to a neurologist.

§ 1201.01(13), (25) and 1264(A); based on the consultant's report.

Motion: Dr. Harris moved to recommend that the Board offer a disciplinary consent agreement requiring a chart audit. In addition, to require the completion of 4 hours of CE in recordkeeping and 4 hours in risk management and proper referral to a specialist.

- A. <u>Open Investigation Case(s)</u>
 - 1. 202200063

Based on the complexity and scope of the case, the Committee considered that additional investigation is needed and that individual cases should be opened against the identified licensees. The Committee considered recommending a cease and desist for New Horizon Clinic including the Implant Pathways CE program.

Motion: Dr. Kalamchi moved to recommend that the Board open a complaint against New Horizon and against the highlighted names of licensed dentists identified in pages 52 and 53 of the Committee's packet. In addition, to recommend revocation of the volunteer registrations of those identified in rows 8, 18 and 26 in the aforementioned pages and not allow them to renew. **Second:** Dr. Berrigan **Vote:** 8-ave, 0-nay, 0-abstain, 0-recuse, 1-absent, 2-vacancies. Motion passed.

Motion: Ms. Kappes moved to recommend that the Board open a case against R.S. due to the deficiencies noted in the consultant's report. Second: Dr. Fukami Vote: 8-aye, 0-nay, 0-abstain, 0-recuse, 1-absent, 2-vacancies. Motion passed.

Motion: Dr. Fukami moved to recommend that the Board open a case against Dr. A.A based on the recordkeeping deficiencies identified in the consultant's report. **Second:** Dr. Harris

- C. <u>Review of Investigation(s)</u>
 - 2. 202200102

The Committee reviewed the consultant's report and discussed the treatment plan, poor recordkeeping and considered a referral would have been appropriate. After

discussion, the Committee agreed that there was a violation of A.R.S. § 32-1201.01(13) and (25).

Ms. Kappes rejoined the meeting at 3:50 p.m.

Motion: Dr. Harris moved to recommend that the Board find violation of A.R.S. § 32-1201.01(13) and (25) based on the consultant's report. Second: Dr. Imtiaz

Vote: 7-aye, 0-nay, 1-abstain, 0-recuse, 1-absent, 2-vacancies. Motion passed. *Ms. Kappes abstained.*

Motion: Dr. Harris moved to recommend that the Board issue a disciplinary consent agreement requiring the completion of 3 hours of CE in record keeping and 6 hours in implant diagnosis, treatment planning and placement. In addition, to order restitution for two-thousand, two hundred and ninety-five dollars; as reflected in the consultant's report.

Vote: 8-aye, 0-nay, 0-abstain, 0-recuse, 1-absent, 2-vacancies. Motion passed.

The Committee reviewed the consultant's report and considered there was inappropriate sinus lift with a complication that was not recognized. The Committee also discussed the respondents' failure to manage complications.

The Committee discussed that the respondent has previously been ordered CE in recordkeeping and considered recommending a chart audit.

Motion: Dr. Harris moved to recommend that the Board offer a disciplinary consent agreement, requiring a chart audit for six months. In addition, to require the completion of 6 hours of CE in diagnosis, treatment planning and referral. **Second:** Dr. Fukami

Vote: 7-aye, 0-nay, 0-abstain, 0-recuse, 2-absent, 2-vacancies. Motion passed.

The Committee discussed that administering the same dose or greater requires a permit based on the current rules.

Motion: Dr. Fukami moved to recommend that the Board issue a letter of concern that entails understanding the limitations of oral sedation with respect to non-permitted providers as reference in A.A..C. R4-11-1303(A)(2)(a)(2). **Second:** Dr. Harris

Vote: 6-aye, 1-nay, 0-abstain, 0-recuse, 2-absent, 2-vacancies. Motion passed. *Dr. Motahari voted against the motion.*

The Committee discussed the failed sedation of the three year old patient and discussed appropriate case selection and management.

Motion: Dr. Imitaz moved to recommend that the Board issue a letter of concern for case selection based on the patient's age and management of a failed sedation. **Second:** Dr. Harris

Based on the consultant's report, the allegation for refabrication of a crown was substantiated because of the open margins. The Committee considered there is a violation of the standard of care.

Motion: Dr. Berrigan moved to recommend that the Board offer a disciplinary consent agreement requiring the completion of 3 hours of CE in implant restoration and order restitution for the crown that was placed on tooth number 13.
