III. NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING (“NPR”)

The Committee began the review of A.A.C. R4-11-1303 and discussed adding a list of emergency drugs and supplies for a dental office or dental clinic to have during the provision of sedation.

Dr. Brownstein joined the meeting at 2:39 p.m.

During discussion, the Committee concurred to add Pretracheal or precordial stethoscope, or End tidal capnography to the list of supplies at a dental office or dental clinic. The Committee further reviewed Subsection C and concurred to replace confirmation of CPR coursework with Basic Life Support HealthCare Provider Level coursework.

Motion: Dr. Snell moved to keep language that “a recognized continuing education course in advanced airway management” for 1303 Permit holders.

Second: Dr. Herro

Vote: 8-aye, 0-nay, 1-abstain, 0-recuse, 1-absent. Motion passed.

Dr. Brady’s vote was not recorded.

The Committee proceeded to review Subsection C related to requirements for initial applicants and concurred to continue discussion at the next meeting.
