The Committee reviewed the consultant's report and confirmed that the business entity is registered with the Board. The Committee identified violation of A.R.S. § 32-1263 for failure to comply with a subpoena in a timely manner. The Committee also considered fining the entity.

Motion: Dr. Fukami moved to recommend that the Board issue the business entity a \$2,000 fine for violation of A.R.S. § 32-1263.

The Committee reviewed the consultant's report and discussed whether the name of the dental assistant taking radiographs should be entered in the chart to verify that person is certified to do so. After discussion, the Committee concurred that the dentist should ensure the dental assistants have proper certification or training to take radiographs.

Motion: Dr. Caputo moved to recommend that the Board issue a letter of concern for the dentist to ensure assistants are appropriately trained or certified on tasks they are assigned to do.

The Committee reviewed the consultant's report and concurred there was deficient root canal treatment on tooth number 2. The Committee identified violation of A.R.S. §32-1201.01(14).

Motion: Dr. Caputo moved to identify violation of A.R.S. § 32-1201.01(14).

Second: Dr. Harris

Vote: 10-aye, 0-nay, 0-abstain, 0-recuse, 1-absent. Motion passed.

Motion: Dr. Caputo moved to recommend that the Board issue disciplinary action, requiring the completion of 4 hours of CE in risk management, 3 hours in ethics, 4 hours in diagnosis and treatment planning of root canal therapy and 4 hours of managing complications of root canal therapy, including appropriate referral. In addition, 4 hours of hands-on CE in instrumentation.

Second: Dr. Kalamchi

The Committee further discussed that not informing the patient of a broken file is a violation. There wasn't a referral for the file to be removed. The Committee also identified recordkeeping and risk management issues.

Motion: Dr. Caputo moved to recommend that the Board issue disciplinary action, requiring the completion of 6 hours of CE in diagnosis and treatment planning for fixed and partial dentures and 4 hours in risk management.

The Committee further reviewed the consultant's report and discussed that the allegation for inadequate reduction of crown prep was substantiated and data points were left out, such as the nitrous concentration anesthetic that was administered to the patient. As such, the Committee considered there is a violation of maintenance of records.

Motion: Dr. Caputo moved to recommend that the Board issue disciplinary action, requiring the completion of 6 hours of CE in diagnosis and treatment plan for restorative, 4 hours in risk management and 4 hours in nitrous oxide oxygen sedation administration and technique.

Vote: 9-aye, 0-nay, 1-abstain, 0-recuse, 1-absent. Motion passed.

Dr. Fukami abstained.

During review of the consultant's report, the Committee concurred that the allegations for improper root canal, failure to diagnose and inform the patient of failed treatment are substantiated.

Motion: Dr. Caputo moved to recommend that the Board issue disciplinary action, requiring the completion of 12 hours of CE in root canal therapy technique, to include hands-on CE in instrumentation, diagnosis, treatment planning and management of complications and 4 hours in risk management. Also, probation for no root canal treatment until the CE is completed. In addition, to order restitution for \$3,001.

The Committee proceeded to discuss that the documentation for sedation is not there, including consent, vital signs and poor records.

Motion: Dr. Caputo recommended suspension of the respondent's 1303 Permit until 30 hours of CE courses in oral conscious sedation or oral moderate sedation and 4 hours in risk management are completed. In addition, to order \$1,407 in restitution.

Second: Dr. Kalamchi

The Committee reviewed the consultant's report and considered the consent was lacking and there was a failure to diagnose a pathologic fracture that occurred. There were also multiple x-rays missing. Of the six allegations, four were substantiated by the investigator.

Second: Dr. Kalamchi

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Motoin: Dr. Harris moved to recommend that the Board issue disciplinary action, requiring the completion of 4 hours of CE in risk management and informed consent, 4 hours in opioid prescription management and 4 hours in management of complications and pathological fractures.

The Committee reviewed the consultant's report and identified that the respondent did not have a 1303 Permit, as required. The Committee discussed whether knowingly practicing without the proper permit rises to a class 6 felony. The Committee also discussed that the patient was classified as an ASA4.

Motion: Dr. Caputo moved to identify violations of A.R.S § 32-1201.01(14) and (24).

Second: Dr. Harris

Vote: 10-aye, 0-nay, 0-abstain, 0-recuse, 1-absent. Motion passed.

Motion: Dr. Caputo moved to recommend that the Board issue disciplinary action, requiring the completion of 3 hours of CE in patient evaluation, 4 hours in risk management and 4 hours in diagnosis and treatment planning in restorative. In addition, 6 months of chart auditing and suspension of the 1303 Permit and prevent from obtaining a 1302 and 1304 Permit until all CE requirements have been completed.
