I. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m. by Dr. Caputo. Roll call of the committee members was taken and a quorum was established.

III. REVIEW, DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

IV. ITEMS FOR REVIEW, DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON BOARD RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee discussed what cases would be appropriate for dismissal based on the information provided.

Motion: Dr. Harris moved to recommend that the Board dismiss the cases for agenda item nos. IV.A.1.202300028, IV.A.3.202300120, IV.A.4.202300158, IV.A.5.202300175, IV.A.6.202300177, IV.A.10.202300208, IV.A.11.202300209, IV.A.17.202300230, IV.A.19.202300234, IV.A.21.202300245, IV.A.22.202300249, IV.A.23.202300254, IV.A.25.202300265, IV.A.30.202300287, IV.A.32.202300289, IV.A.35.202300299, IV.A.36.202300314, IV.A.37.202300328 and IV.A.40.202300364.  - 7. 202300184

Motion: The Committee moved to recommend that the Board issue a letter of concern emphasizing the importance of thorough and complete recordkeeping, including information such as dental materials used.

Vote: 9-aye, 0-nay, 0-abstain, 0-recuse, 2-absent. Motion passed.

12.202300211

The Committee discussed that the sedation record was not complete and they did not see a specific sedation consent. The Committee further discussed that the time sequence represented in the record was not accurate and there was no specific information regarding the use of supplemental oxygen.

Motion: The Committee moved to recommend that the Board issue a letter of concern emphasizing the importance of appropriate consent specific to moderate sedation and having a sedation record that reflects time accurately in compliance with the board's sedation rules.

Motion: The Committee moved to recommend that the Board issue a letter of concern recommending that the respondent consider the availability of translation resources as a reasonable approach which may help prevent future communication challenges. Also, to indicate that it is not historically appropriate to use a family member for translation unless no other translation service is available. **Vote:** 9-aye, 0-nay, 0-abstain, 0-recuse, 2-absent. Motion passed.

Based on the review of the consultant's report, the Committee identified violation of A.R.S. 32-1263(D)(7) and (12) against the business entity.

Motion: Dr. Caputo moved to identify violation of A.R.S. \S 32-1263(D)(7) and (12) and recommended that the Board assess a \$2,000 civil penalty for each violation.

The Committee reviewed the consultant's report and discussed a potential violation of A.R.S. 32-1201.01(14) due to the dentist allowing the minor child to place material in the mouth.

Motion: Dr. Caputo moved to recommend that the Board issue a non-disciplinary order, requiring the completion of 3 hours of CE in ethics and 6 hours in administration of sedation, including dose, time of discharge, meeting appropriate discharge criteria and appropriate discharge to an adult.

Second: Dr. Fukami

Vote: 9-aye, 0-nay, 0-abstain, 0-recuse, 2-absent. Motion passed.

Based on the review of the consultant's report, the Committee identified violation of A.R.S. § 32-1201.01(14).

Motion: Dr. Caputo moved to identify violation of A.R.S. § 32-1201.01(14). Second: Dr. Harris Vote: 9-aye, 0-nay, 0-abstain, 0-recuse, 2-absent. Motion passed.

Motion: Dr. Harris moved to recommend that the Board offer disciplinary action, requiring the completion of 3 hours of CE in surgical complication management and 4 hours in risk management.

Second: Dr. Caputo

Vote: 9-aye, 0-nay, 0-abstain, 0-recuse, 2-absent. Motion passed.

Based on the review of the consultant's report, the Committee identified violation of A.R.S. § 32-1201.01(14) and (24). Deviations from the standard of care include, no treatment plan for root canal of tooth number 14, not charting details of the root canal such as amount of canals, location of the tooth, the working lengths and file lengths. In addition, the respondent's failure to follow up after the separated file, inadequate treatment and that there is no indication that a rubber dam was used.

Motion: Dr. Caputo moved to identify violation of A.R.S. § 32-1201.01(14) and (24).

Second: Dr. Asrari

Vote: 9-aye, 0-nay, 0-abstain, 0-recuse, 2-absent. Motion passed.

Motion: Dr. Caputo moved to recommend that the Board offer disciplinary action, requiring participation in CRDTS' C.A.R.E.S. program and the completion of 12 hours of CE in endodontics. In addition, \$2,954 in restitution to the insurance and \$1,334.20 to the patient.

Motion: Dr. Caputo moved to recommend that the Board offer disciplinary action, requiring participation in CRDTS' C.A.R.E.S. program and the completion of 6 hours of CE in implants. In addition, to consider potential restitution in the amount of \$2,250 to be further reviewed and confirmed by the Board. Also, to consider a referral to the Arizona Department of Insurance and Financial Institute for investigation of financial and billing practices and for the Board to consider conducting an audit of the practice.

Motion: Dr. Caputo moved to recommend that the Board issue a \$2,000 civil penalty and order restitution in the amount of \$420. Second: Dr. Harris Vote: 9-aye, 0-nay, 0-abstain, 0-recuse, 2-absent. Motion passed.

The Committee moved to recommend that the Board issue a letter of concern to Dr. N.S., as identified in the consultant's report, emphasizing the importance of thorough and complete charting and clinical notes.

Based on the review of the consultant's report, the Committee identified violation of A.R.S. § 32-1201.01(24) and 32-1264(D) for failure to timely respond with a request for records. During discussion, the Committee took into consideration the possible turnover from acquiring a practice.

Motion: Dr. Caputo moved to identify violation of A.R.S. § 32-1264(D). Second: Dr. Harris Vote: 7-aye, 2-nay, 0-abstain, 0-recuse, 2-absent. Motion passed. *Drs. Berrigan and Fukami voted against the motion.*

Motion: Dr. Caputo moved to recommend that the Board offer disciplinary action, requiring the completion of 3 hours of CE in ethics and a \$500 penalty. Second: Ms. Kappes Vote: 7-aye, 1-nay, 1-abstain, 0-recuse, 2-absent. Motion passed. Dr. Berrigan voted against the motion. Dr. Fukami abstained.

Based on the review of the consultant's report, the Committee identified violation of A.R.S. § 32-1201.01(14).
