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**NOTICE OF MEETING**  
OF THE ARIZONA STATE BOARD OF DENTAL EXAMINERS’  
INVESTIGATIVE COMMITTEE

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statute (“A.R.S”) § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the Arizona State Board of Dental Examiners’ (“Board”) **Investigative Committee** (“Committee”) and to the general public that the Committee will hold a meeting open to the public on **Tuesday, January 21, 2025 at 1:00 p.m.** The meeting will be held in virtual and telephonic formats. Members of the public may also participate virtually or telephonically. Committee members and members of the public may access the meeting telephonically by dialing +1 484-416-1815 followed by the meeting pin – 966 476 947# or virtually, by video conferencing through this link: [meet.google.com/bvs-xtex-xrg](https://meet.google.com/bvs-xtex-xrg). After the start of the meeting, the Committee chairperson and/or staff will request that members of the public place their phones/devices on mute.

Meetings of the Committee are open to the public, and are conducted in a manner to ensure that the Board's deliberations are not disrupted. Therefore, the following statement shall be considered the only warning of proper decorum: "each person who addresses the Committee must do so in an orderly manner and must not make impertinent, slanderous, threatening, abusive or profane remarks to any member of the Board, staff, licensee, complainant or general public. Any person who engages in any disorderly conduct that disrupts, disturbs, or otherwise impedes the orderly conduct of any meeting will be removed from the current meeting and closely monitored should they decide to attend future meetings".

During the course of the meeting, the Committee, upon a majority vote of a quorum of the members, may, when necessary, hold an executive session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(2) and/or (3) as indicated on the Committee’s Agenda. The executive session is not open to the public.

Information concerning the Committee’s Agenda, including a copy of the Agenda and any amendments, can be obtained at the Board’s office, through the Board’s website at [www.dentalboard.az.gov](http://www.dentalboard.az.gov) or by calling the Board’s office at 602-241-1492. The Committee Agenda is subject to change up to 24 hours prior to the meeting. Agenda items are noted by number and letter for convenience and reference. The Committee may address the agenda items in any order within the time frame, if any, indicated and may set over matters to a later time when necessary. The Committee reserves the right to change the order of the agenda items, except for matters set for a specific time.
