Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statute ("A.R.S") § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the Arizona State Board of Dental Examiners' ("Board") **Anesthesia & Sedation Evaluation Committee** ("Committee") and to the general public that the Committee will hold a meeting open to the public on **Friday, June 20, 2025 at 3:00 p.m.** The meeting will be held in virtual and telephonic formats. Members of the public may also participate virtually or telephonically. After the start of the meeting, the Committee chairperson and/or staff will request that members of the public place their phones/devices on mute.

Meetings of the Committee are open to the public, and are conducted in a manner to ensure that the Board's deliberations are not disrupted. Therefore, the following statement shall be considered the only warning of proper decorum: "each person who addresses the Committee must do so in an orderly manner and must not make impertinent, slanderous, threatening, abusive or profane remarks to any member of the Board, staff, licensee, complainant or general public. Any person who engages in any disorderly conduct that disrupts, disturbs, or otherwise impedes the orderly conduct of any meeting will be removed from the current meeting and closely monitored should they decide to attend future meetings".

During the course of the meeting, the Committee, upon a majority vote of a quorum of the members, may, when necessary, hold an executive session pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(2) and/or (3) as indicated on the Committee's Agenda. The executive session is not open to the public.

The Committee reserves the right to change the order of the agenda items, except for matters set for a specific time.
