Agenda Item No. 1 – Call to Order and Instructions

Dr. Waite called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

Agenda Item No. 2 – Alexander C. Hatch, D.D.S. – Case No 201100145: Review, discussion and possible action on 1) Dr. Hatch's voluntary suspension and 2) Amended Stipulation Agreement and Order for participation in the monitored aftercare treatment program.

Dr. Sucher has reviewed this. Dr. Hatch was placed in the public program before there was a confidential program. Dr. Hatch will start over with his five years in the public program.

Upon MOTION by Dr. Woods, second by Ms. Crevier, the Board voted to APPROVE the voluntary suspension of the license of Dr. Alexander Hatch. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY

Upon MOTION by Dr. Woods, second by Ms. Crevier, the Board voted to ACCEPT the amended Stipulation Agreement and Order to participate in the monitored aftercare treatment program with the five years starting over. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY

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Agenda Item No. 3 – Sarah G. Morones, R.D.H. – Case No. 201300179: Review, discussion and possible action on 1) the reinstatement of Ms. Morones' license and 2) the Stipulation Agreement and Order for participation in the monitored aftercare treatment program

Ms. Morones entered into the program before there was a confidential program. The Board previously approved her voluntary suspension; so therefore a motion is needed to reinstate her license. The Board wanted to ensure that Ms. Morones would be monitored and Board staff ensured that Ms. Morones would be monitored while participating in the program. Ms. Morones will start over with her five years in the public program.

Upon MOTION by Dr. Hauer, second by Dr. Foster, the Board voted to REINSTATE the license of Ms. Morones. Mr. Jackson OPPOSED. MOTION PASSED

A new stipulation agreement was needed as the parameters for the program had changed.

Upon MOTION by Dr. Woods, second by Dr. Foster, the Board voted to ACCEPT the Stipulation Agreement and Order for participation in the monitored aftercare treatment program. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY
